The Department can confirm that present staff have now been trained on the previously shared training materials as required in Paragraph 3.

While we believe this represents substantial compliance as contemplated by the settlement agreement, and as impacted by the COVID Public Health Emergency, the Department plans to continue to review the cases until there are none pending.
