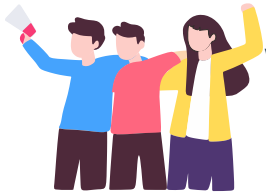

Over 1 million people  
are at risk of losing  
Medicaid

THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN & FAMILIES (DCF)  
HAS BEGUN REVIEWING MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY FOR  
APPROXIMATELY 5 MILLION FLORIDIANS.  
GROUPS LIKELY TO BE IMPACTED INCLUDE:

### Young people



Who have recently turned  
19 or 20 and those who  
used to be in foster care  
who are now over age 26

### Parents



Parents & caregivers  
whose income is now too  
high to qualify for Medicaid  
or no longer have a minor  
child

### Aged & Disabled Individuals





Who are now  
eligible for Medicare
